

**KORU SCHOOL (1336)**  
**Enrolment Scheme**  
Effective from 29 January 2008

**Home Zone**

The Board of Trustees of Koru School advises proposed amendments to our enrolment scheme as recommended by the Ministry of Education

The changes are principally to clarify our boundary and to prevent overcrowding in future years

**All students who live within Koru school home zone described below (and shown on the attached map) shall be eligible to enrol at the school.**

Starting at the intersection of McKenzie Road (excluded) and Walmsley Road travel east along the centre of Walmsley Road (even numbers) to the intersection with Robertson Road.

Turn south along the centre of Robertson Road (1-73 odd numbers) to Cameo Court Road (excluded), and then both sides of Robertson Road (75-91 and 60-78). Includes the housing development on the previously owned hospital grounds. Gadsby Road (64, 57 and below) and Tua, Royalpark, Glenpark, Atiu, Regalwood Places and Enuamanu Road are included.

Turn west along the Northern Boundaries of the Mangere Central Reserve and Moyle Park. The zone then travels north along Bader Drive (excluded), to McKenzie Road and back to the starting point.

All residential addresses on both sides of boundary roads and exit roads off boundary roads are included in the zone unless otherwise stated

**Special Programmes**

This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a Special programme approved by the Secretary.

**Out of Zone Enrolments**

Each year the Board of Trustees will determine the number of places which are likely to be available in the following year for the enrolment of students who live outside the home zone. The Board will publish this information by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. The notice will indicate how applications are to be made and will specify a date by which all applications must be received.

**Applications for enrolments will be processed in the following order of priority:**

**First Priority**        This priority is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a special programme approved by the Secretary for Education.

**Second Priority**       will be given to applicants who are siblings of current students.

**Third Priority**        will be given to applicants who are siblings of former students.

**Fourth Priority**       will be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school.

**Fifth Priority**        will be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the board of the school or a child of a member of the board of the school.

**Sixth Priority**        will be given to all other applicants.

If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth or fifth priority groups than there are places available, Selection within the priority group will be by ballot conducted in accordance with instructions by the

Secretary. Under Section 11G (1) on the Education Act 1989. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school.

**Applicants seeking second or third priority status may be required to give proof of a sibling relationship.**
